The Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) is a charge that local authorities can set on new developments in their area. Its purpose is to raise funds for infrastructure needs in the area to support growth. A portion of the CIL income raised from development, within a local council area, is paid to that local council where development has taken place.

Arun District Council is committed to supporting its town and parish councils in feeling confident and well-informed when it comes to spending their CIL funds.

This CIL Spend Strategy document helps town and parish councils set out a clear plan for how CIL funds will be used. Developing a defined spending strategy, particularly where funds are being saved for a specific project, helps confirm that projects are feasible and deliverable within a reasonable timeframe.

As part of the CIL spending process, the CIL Assessment, Spend & Monitoring Officer is available to support town and parish councils in developing and refining their spending strategies.
