It was decided at the meeting to contact Anthony Baker at ADC to clarify the fact that slabs provided by the Snooks Corner Group were still there, and that any vegetation should be removed as part of the maintenance program.

FPC would be willing to support an application put in by Snooks Corner Group but would not wish to incur installing / maintenance / emptying / Biffa costs. This was agreed.
